⇒ Focus on reading skills such as:

- Sequencing

⇒ Strengthen writing skills in the areas of:

- 6 Traits of Writing
- Organization
- Sentence and paragraph structure
- Use of effective vocabulary.

⇒ \$200 per student for each week due at the beginning of the first session. This includes folder, supplies, final writing piece, and follow up information about strengths and weaknesses for the incoming school year.

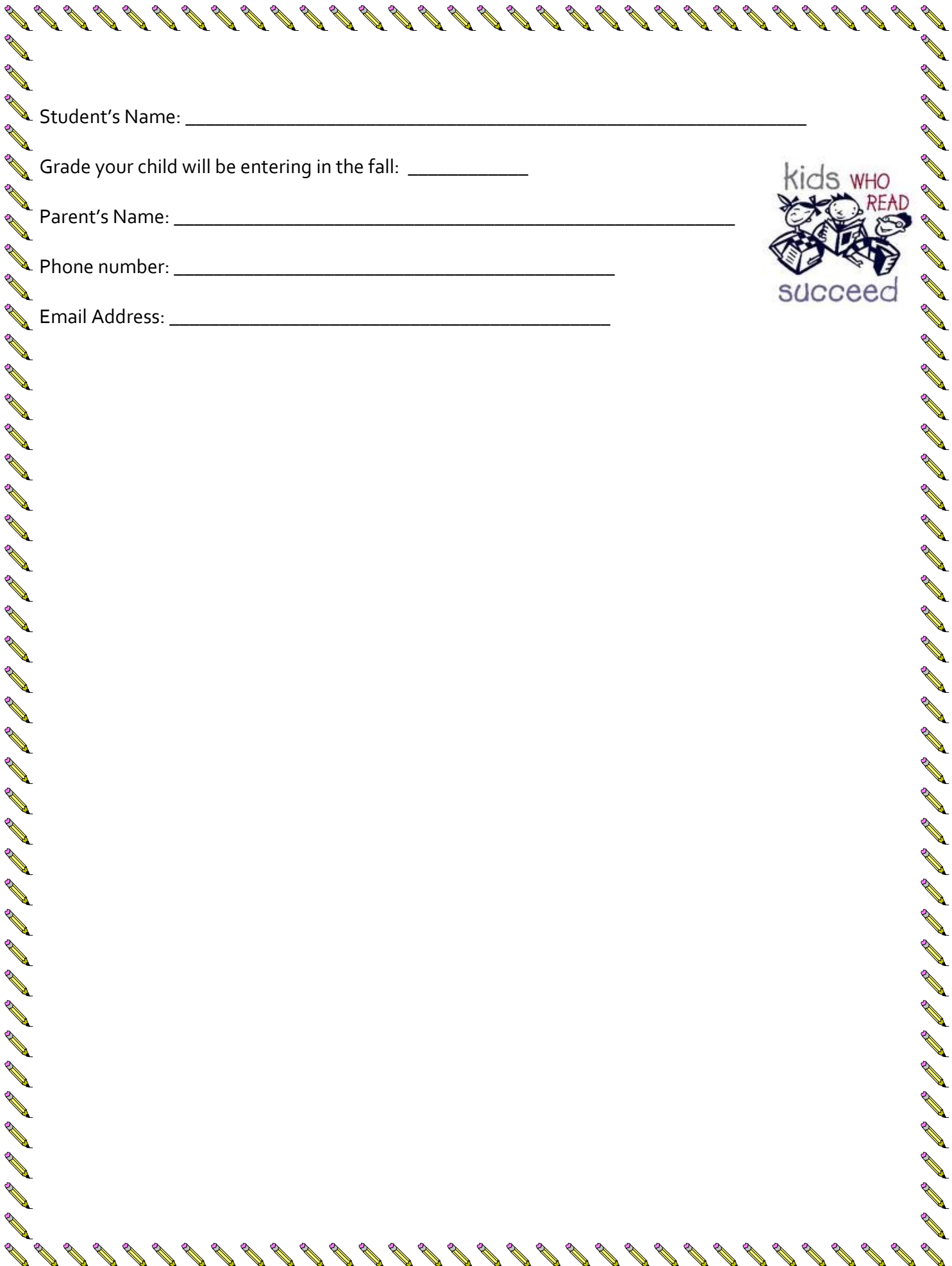
